\$43 Billion

Target to build 240,000 housing units...

Ministry of Municipalities and Housing has started a five-year \$43 billion plan for the construction of housing across the Kingdom. The program involves the construction of 240,000 units. It is one of the largest of its kind anywhere in the world. New housing units will be built in urban areas all over the Kingdom. The plan is creating wide spread opportunities for residential infrastructure suppliers, construction companies, suppliers of interior fixtures, fittings and finishing material and other related construction products and services.

In addition to the Giga Projects, high-demand in the new housing developments...

SEDRA – An integrated community inspired by Salmani architecture. Covers 20 Million sqm and will feature more than 30,000 homes.

ALAROUS – Inspired by the historical city of Jeddah, the architecture blends modern and traditional design. Covers 4 Million sqm and will have 18,000 homes.

WAREFA – ROSHN's second community in Riyadh covers 1.4 Million sqm and will deliver more than 2,000 new homes.

ALFULWA – The first integrated community in the Eastern Province covers more than 10.8 Million sqm and will provide 18,000 homes.

Diriyah Gate Project Offers Many Short Term Opportunities...

The Diriyah Gate master plan offers a wide range of opportunities. Some 38 new hotels and resorts will be opening in Diriyah, alongside museums, cultural attractions, luxury retail outlets and souqs. Housing adjacent to the tourism facilities are also being rapidly developed. The project offers architects, engineers, construction companies and the entire supply chain of materials and equipment providers widespread opportunities.



\$23 Billion

King Salman Park Development is Accelerating...

Construction is underway at King Salman Park. The largest urban park in the world park, will incorporate arts, education, sports, leisure, retail and hospitality facilities and 12,000 residential units over 13.4 sqm in the center of Riyadh. The mega-development requires heavy construction machinery, all manner of building materials, architectural, interior design and other consultancy services. Suppliers of greenery, water features and equipment are also needed.



\$50 Billion

Covering 19 Million Square Meters and Housing 420,000 Residents...

Riyadh's New Murabba is set to open for the 2030 World Expo. It will feature 420,000 residents, 9,000 hotel rooms, 980,000 sqm of retail space, a museum, a university, entertainment and culture venues. Suppliers of architectural and construction services, including architectural consultancies, construction companies and other building services providers, including providers of construction materials, machinery and equipment as well as landscaping are needed.

The Sports Boulevard's Unique Offering...

The outdoor and indoor linear park will be rich in sporting, artistic, cultural and eco activities, to create a sustainable healthy lifestyle. The boulevard will have 8 districts spanning 135 km in and around the city of Riyadh. The project includes arts, entertainment, and multiple sports facilities. Opportunities for infrastructure and sports facility constructors, building materials, landscaping, public realm and associated providers are required.

\$6 Trillion

Tourism Investment Provides Massive Construction Opportunities...

Saudi Arabia is offering investment opportunities worth \$6 Trillion in the travel and tourism sector as the Kingdom steadily pursues its journey to emerge as a global tourist destination by the end of the decade. The opportunities for providers of tourism infrastructure, constructors of hotels, hospitality, entertainment and event facilities as well as all associated services are increasing at an accelerated rate.



315,000

Hotel Room Growth...

The Kingdom has announced the development of 315,000 hotel rooms in Saudi by 2030 further expanding opportunities in this sector. This massive expansion will fuel growth across the full range of requirements of building sector materials, products, and services, throughout the Kingdom.



700,000

Visitors to Trojena...

Trojena, Saudi Arabia's premier winter sports mega-resort is due to be completed in 2026. Work is well underway. Trojena is situated in an area of NEOM. Plans include homes for 7,000 permanent residents and hotel and leisure facilities for more than 700,000 visitors annually. Saudi Arabia has been chosen to host the 2029 Asian Winter Games at Trojena.

\$20 Billion

Jeddah Central Transformation...

Jeddah will see an area of 5.7 million sqm developed in three phases, the first of which will welcome visitors in 2027. A 9.5 km waterfront with a world class marina and some 2,700 hotel rooms as well as an opera house, museum, sports stadium and oceanarium. The \$20 Billion project offers exceptional opportunities for the residential, commercial, retail and infrastructure sectors.



\$14.74 Billion

For Smart Cities Construction...

The Saudi Arabian smart cities market size is projected to reach \$14.74 Billion by 2027. Advancements of the Smart Cities Communications Infrastructure encompass upgrading the adoption of modern technologies that will be embedded in commercial, residential and infrastructure projects. The transformation plans are creating opportunities for construction companies, infrastructure providers, maintenance providers and manufactures.



\$26 Billion

For Massive Saudi Land Bridge Projects...

Land Bridge projects include the construction of 950 km of new rail lines between Riyadh and Jeddah, and 115 km of new lines between Dammam and Jubail. The investment of \$26 Billion over 5 – 7 years will require heavy construction machinery and materials, as well as consultancy services over a prolonged period providing a variety of opportunities for rail infrastructure suppliers and other related construction products and services.



\$9.8 Billion

Qiddiya the Future of Entertainment...

Qiddiya City will take up more than 334 square kilometers on the outskirts of Riyadh. Work has been under way on the \$9.8 Billion since 2023. The first phase, Six Flags is due to open in 2025. Qiddiya's rapid development is offering a wide range of opportunities to suppliers of construction materials, specialist entertainment construction services as well as many public realm and infrastructure development contracts.

\$60 Billion

Jeddah Metro Offers Opportunities for Infrastructure and Public Facilities...

Jeddah Metro will consist of 74 stations, 160 km of track and 4 individual routes through the city. The \$60 Billion project will offer high budget infrastructure and public facilities. At each metro station will provide further construction opportunities in retail, hospitality and tourism sectors that cluster around transport nodes.



3.7 Million SQM

PIF to Develop Al Balad Historic District, Jeddah...

The overall project development area will comprise approximately 2.5 Million sqm with a total built up area of 3.7 Million sqm. Construction and related business opportunities to develop 9,300 residential units, 1,800 hotel units and around 1.3 Million sqm of commercial and office space needing interior fit outs and finishings.



\$15 Billion

Al Ula...

The Royal Commission for Al Ula's archaeological, cultural and touristic complex is an open-air living museum. The area is as vast as Belgium. The \$15 Billion Al Ula master plan is being developed in three phases in 2023, 2030, and 2035. The major investment aims to make the Al Ula region the Kingdom's cultural capital. Investments – public and private – in new hotels, restaurants, retail and leisure facilities are continually leading to new projects. The opportunities for the construction industry are massive and on-going.



230,000 SQM

Jabal Omar Project Accelerates...

The Jabal Omar development project in Makkah is a unique urban regeneration scheme. The integrated development will provide hotel accommodations, commercial / retail spaces, cars parking, public spaces and public amenities to support religious, social and commercial activities for Hajj and Umrah pilgrims. The land area of the project is approximately 230,000 sqm with a built-up floor area of approximately 2 million sqm. Construction and infrastructure development opportunities are accelerating as the various projects get underway.
